

Georgia Law (O.C.G.A. § 19-3-35.1) requires that each person applying for a marriage license must receive from the office of the probate judge the HIV and Marriage brochure, which includes information about HIV infection, prevention measures, and HIV test sites. Marriage licenses will not be issued unless each proposed spouse signs a form acknowledging that they have received the brochure and testing information.
