## Reimagine Water

There is no limit to imagination! Many talented artists featured in this calendar have put their imagination to work, inspiring us to rethink water in creative ways. Let them be your inspiration as you reimagine water—and take action!

## Use Your WaterSense to Reimagine Conservation

Many of us are already aware that there is a need to conserve water in Fulton County and metro-Atlanta. Our water source, the Chattahoochee River, is one of the smallest watersheds in the country to serve a major metropolitan area. Meanwhile, our population continues to grow, requiring us to support more people each year with those same water resources. In addition, while our region receives nearly 50 inches of precipitation in an average year, we are also prone to periods of moderate to severe drought which makes water conservation even more essential.

It can be difficult to get excited about conservation because the language we use to describe it often makes it sound like we are having to give something up or deprive ourselves of something. We are told to “use less”, “reduce our use”, or “take a shorter shower”, for example. For some people this can be frustrating and discouraging, but with a little imagination and some help from WaterSense, we can reimagine conservation to save more water while still living our best lives.

WaterSense is a program of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency. It is similar to the EnergyStar rating program for appliances, but it is used instead for water fixtures such as toilets, showerheads, faucets, and irrigation system components. WaterSense labeled fixtures are third-party tested for both efficiency and performance. By identifying fixtures that provide water more efficiently, WaterSense helps us guide our decisions when it’s time to update our bathroom, kitchen, or yard toward products that will help us save water without sacrificing anything.

When you purchase a WaterSense labeled product, you can rest assured that it has been proven not only to save water but also to perform as well as or better than other similar products. For example, a WaterSense labeled showerhead uses no more than 2 gallons of water per minute, half a gallon less than a standard shower head. For a ten minute shower, you can save 5 whole gallons with a WaterSense showerhead without changing anything else! And since showers use warm water, you’re also conserving energy.



WaterSense also has a wide variety of interactive activities and educational materials for parents, students, and educators, as well as for businesses. They can help us assess our current water use, plan our new landscape, find available rebate programs, check our homes for water leaks, and much more.
