# Home Page



- · Includes LinkedIn News of the Day
- Recommends readings, groups and people that you might be interested in
- Shows who has new connections
- Displays those who were endorsed by others
- Everyone can endorse whoever they choose
- Lists new activities for your connections

- Shows everyone in your address book
- Allows you to grow your LinkedIn group
- Tag contacts into subgroups... friends, colleagues, clients, classmates....
- Sort and search by last name, company, location and even by industry

- Company

#### Free Version Features:

- Basic account to build a network
- 5 introductions at a time
- · View only 100 results per search
- Save up to 3 searches
- · Receive unlimited InMails
- · Limited use of who has viewed your profile
- · Limited view of full profile

#### **Business Account**

- Features:
- Full view of who has viewed your profile
- Full profile view
- 10 InMails a month
- 15 introductions a month
- Anyone can message you for free
- 300 profiles per search

# **Closing Tips**


- Be open to new options... different line of work, new field, etc.
